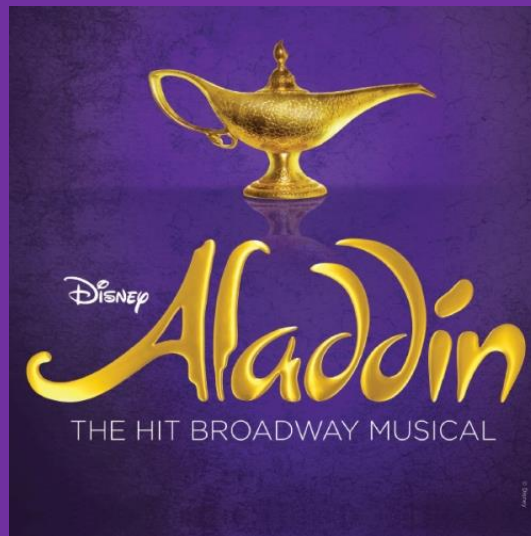

I may have to take an elevator to get to my seat.

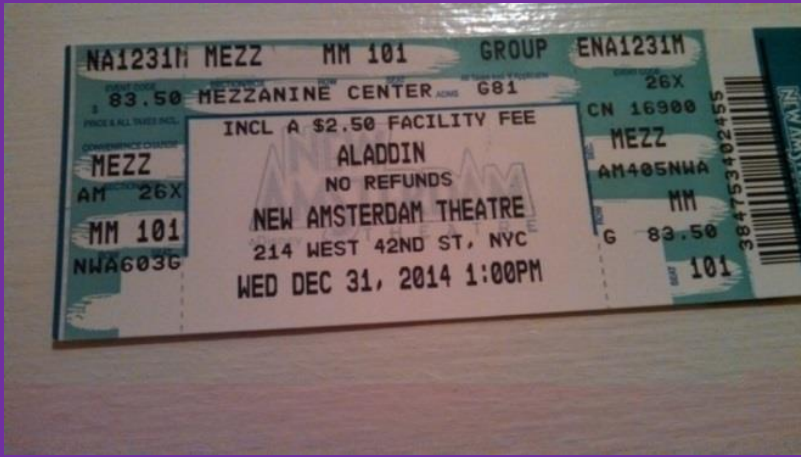
I will go into the theatre.

will clap.

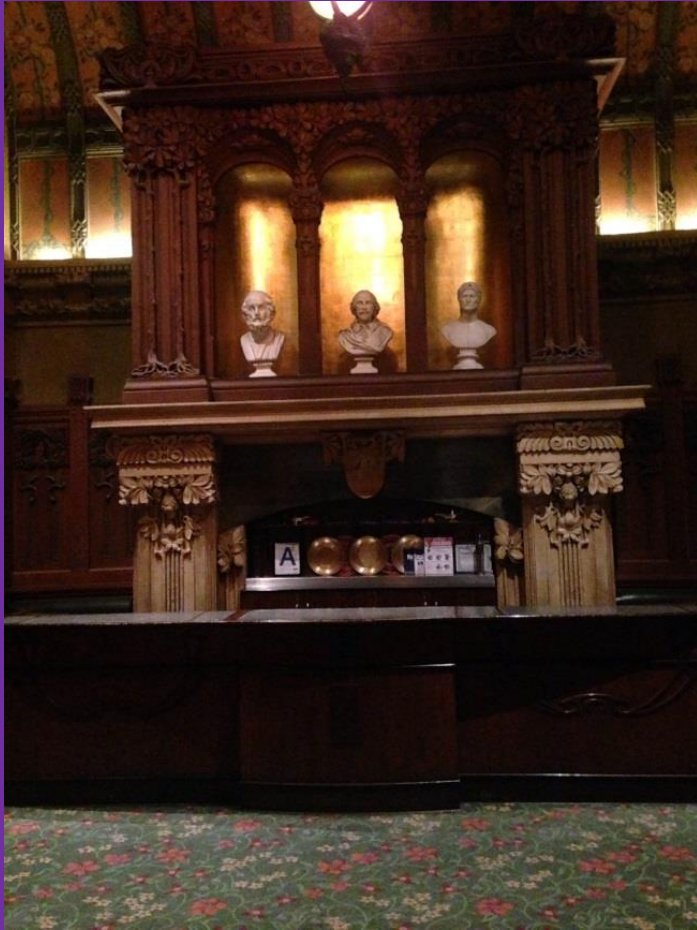
Clapping tells the actors
